1. CALL TO ORDER

The Deputy Mayor called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m.

(1) ADOPTION OF AGENDA

2. DECLARATIONS OF PECUNIARY INTEREST

Councillor Crookshank declared a pecuniary interest regarding item 6: Water Access for 2 Remy Bay Road, as he is the owner of the property. Councillor Gilbert declared a pecuniary interest with regard to item 5b: the Planner's Monthly Report as his property was mentioned and with item 6: Water Access for 2 Remy Bay Road as he owns the property next to the Snug Harbour Docks.

3. PUBLIC MEETING – ZONING BY-LAW AMENDMENT Z/2021/02 FREDERIKSEN

The Planner provided an overview of zoning by-law amendment Z/2021/02. No members of the public came forward to address this amendment; no letters of opposition were received.
