Fees

Bulky Items, other than recyclable items	\$10.00
Clean wood waste - Single axle trailer or half ton truck	\$25.00

Shingles are permitted at the Landfill Site at a cost of **\$10/bundle**.

Vouchers must be purchased in advance at the Municipal Office and presented to the Landfill Site Attendant before shingles can be deposited.

Examples of Bulky Items: Furniture, vacuum cleaners, toilets, sinks, patio furniture (Not Metal) and any items so designated by the Superintendent.

MUNICIPAL PERMIT CARD MUST BE SHOWN. *If no rear-view mirror exists, ensure the permit is displayed and clearly visible on the driver's side of the vehicle.*
